This 6-year old is one of three siblings who received financial support through Always Home's Childcare Solutions Program for camp with before- and after-care. Mom and Dad are grateful that they can continue working their full-time jobs while their children are having an enriching and fun-filled summer.

With grants from **Groton Utilities**, **Mystic Woman's Club** and **Rotary Club of Mystic** and ongoing support from **The Whaler's Inn**, Always Home helped a total of 15 families send 21 children to summer camp. Now that's a lot of happy campers!



FAMILIES SERVED FISCAL YEAR 2024 VS FISCAL YEAR 2023



From July 1, 2023 - June 30, 2024, Always Home served 458 families in housing crisis. This represents a 42.7% increase from the families assisted in Fiscal Year 2023 and marks the highest number of families served in a single year since our organization's founding 26 years ago. Incomes of low-wage workers are not keeping pace with the rising cost of living. The data indicates that as rent prices continue to increase, more low-income families are finding it difficult to afford housing.

Always Home is committed to Preventing Family Homelessness, but we cannot achieve our goals without the support of the community. In the year ahead, donations we receive will help families remain stably housed and out of emergency shelter, ensuring that children do not face the hardship of losing their homes.
